ACRE 2019 SAUVIGNON BLANC, NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES

Crisp, clean, and fresh, the 2019 Sauvignon Blanc is a bright green-gold hue with aromatic notes of apricot, white peaches, nectarine and citrus blossoms accented by hints of green apple, Kaffir lime, and stone. The vibrant acidity is nicely balanced across the palate with a rich and textured mouthfeel. The finish is refreshing and complex with a layered minerality.

GROWING REGION - YOUNTVILLE AVA

Our 2019 Sauvignon Blanc comes from the Block House Vineyard, which is located in the charming town of Yountville between Yountville Crossroad, Yount Mill Road, and the Napa River. The vineyard is named after pioneer George C. Yount's block house, which was built on the site. The family-owned vineyard has been organically and sustainably farmed for over 30 years. The Block House Vineyard enjoys both warm days on the Valley floor and cooler nights by the Napa River, which yields expressive wines with vibrant acidity.

VINTAGE

Despite some extreme weather at the beginning of the year, 2019 was an excellent vintage with a near perfect harvest. The beginning of the growing season was defined by significant rainfall. The long, warm summer saw very few heat spikes, and the foggy mornings provided the perfect backdrop for dynamic and expressive wines. The long, relatively mild finish to the season, not without its moments of unpredictability, helped to preserve freshness and finesse in the fruit with extended hang time teasing out great color, structure, and soft tannins.
