TASTING NOTES

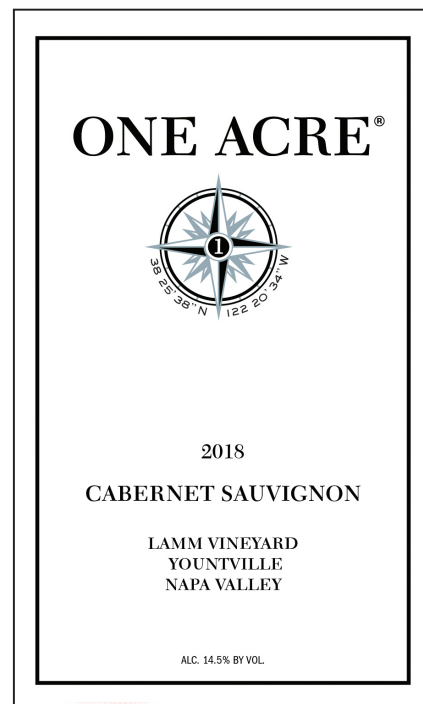
The 2018 One Acre Lamm Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is easily the finest Lamm Vineyard we have ever produced. With dark violet hues, and lovely, expressive aromatics, this Cabernet represents all that is possible in the Napa Valley. The essence of boysenberry, blackberry, black cherry, cassis, cola, saddle leather and bakers spice waft from the glass. On the palate, the rich, lush mouthfeel combines the fruit in the aromatics, black fruits, cassis, leather, lanolin, and spice with fine fruit and oak tannins, great balance and a touch of iron and minerals in a long, lingering finish. Still young, but starting to show just how stunning it will become, this wine will continue to beautifully unfold for years to come.

VINEYARD – LAMM VINEYARD, YOUNTVILLE

Taking cuttings from the original One Acre Oak Knoll Porchview Vineyard, One Acre Founder, Dave Becker, planted the Yountville Lamm Vineyard in 2011 to the same clonal configuration he used in his Porchview Vineyard, Clones 337, 191 and 338. The vineyard is planted just north of the intersection of the Silverado trail and the Yountville crossroad at the base of Stags Leap, where it is exposed to both early morning and late afternoon sun. The soil is a combination of loamy sedimentary and rocky volcanic that allows the roots to go deep and deliver the earth's unique character to the vines. The vineyard spacing is tight resulting in low yields, small clusters, and tiny berries with intense flavors.

VINTAGE 2018

A perfect growing season, easily the best in the last two decades. It started with abundant rainfall, followed by a mild spring that resulted in excellent flowering. A summer of moderate and unhurried warmth achieved full and balanced ripening in the Lamm Vineyard. This Cabernet Sauvignon was picked on October 8th under perfect weather conditions. Fermentation proceeded normally and resulted in this beautifully balanced wine that was matured 28 months in French oak before bottling.
